The Bright Futures Summer Program is for preschool age children (3-5) with a visual impairment as a primary or secondary disability. All activities address pre-academics, socialization and communication skills.

Therapies are delivered through play and stimulate development of compensatory skills, such as pre-mobility and daily living skills. We incorporate an Active Learning philosophy using specifically designed equipment and instruction practices for children with multiple disabilities.

Students will enjoy multi-sensory learning through outdoor play, arts and crafts, weekly field trips, music and educational based therapies. Weekly themes will focus on art, music, nature and sports.

Program Details:

- Fee: \$750.00 (includes tuition, snacks and weekly field trip). Funding may be available to those who qualify
- Staff includes a team of dedicated, compassionate and experienced therapists and teachers
- Small student-to-teacher ratio
- Transportation not provided
