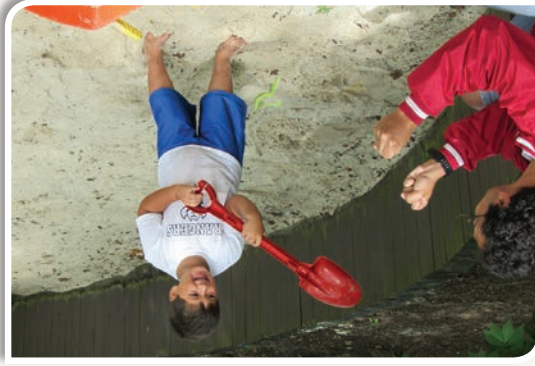


**Highbrook Lodge has been providing a quality summer camp experience for individuals with vision loss and blindness for 89 years.**

## TRADITIONAL ADULT SESSIONS

Traditional adult sessions – for campers ages 22+ – offer structure and independence all in one. Adult campers are housed in gender-specific cabins with peers of similar age and ability. Skilled staff provide supervision for adult campers while encouraging independence and growth. Daily, we offer a large number of adapted, structured programs that campers are able to choose from. Outdoor activity skills, canoeing/fishing trips, and end of the session banquet dinners are unique offerings for adult sessions.

### Adult Celebration (Session 1)

*For adults with multiple disabilities in addition to their vision loss; includes campers who are deaf & blind. Staff to camper ratio is 2:6.*

### Adult Resort (Session 2)

*For adults with vision loss or blindness. All campers must be able to manage their own activities of daily living with minimal support. Staff to camper ratio is 2:8.*

### Adult Day Trip (Session 3)

## FAMILY SESSIONS

These sessions are geared towards the youngest campers and their immediate families. Families with a child ages 0 to 6 years with blindness or vision loss are invited to enjoy a relaxing, fun-filled weekend. For overnight sessions, families are housed in their own cabin – space permitting. Parent sessions, family programming and appropriate activities for children of all ages are included. Evenings culminate in a family activity followed by a traditional campfire. Meet new families while enjoying time with your own. Unable to attend the whole weekend? Check out the first ever day-only option! Apply early as spots are limited!

## SPECIALTY ADULT SESSIONS

This summer two specialty adult sessions are being offered for campers who love being active! Returning for its second summer, Fit & Fabulous Camp is for adults ages 40-60 who want a jam-packed, yet low-impact camp schedule; while the Young Adult Camp focuses on campers ages 22-40 looking for a non-stop, active weekend. Both sessions focus on introducing campers to a wide range of sports, leisure and recreation activities they can continue to pursue outside of camp. All campers must be able to manage their own activities of daily living independently and be able to participate in an active schedule. Staff to camper ratio is 2:8.

### Fit and Fabulous Camp (Session 11)

*For active adults ages 40-60 with blindness/vision loss to explore low-impact leisure and recreation activities.*

**Depart Camp:** Sunday, August 6 at 3pm  
**Transportation:** Available for extra fee  
**Application Fee:** \$20  
**Session Fee:** \$130

### Young Adult Camp (Session 12)

*For active young adults (ages 22-40) interested in spending a weekend with peers focused on activities that include goalball, archery, canoeing and the like.*

## YOUTH SESSIONS

Youth Sessions are a great way for campers ages 7-21 with blindness or vision loss to experience summer camp! Campers are housed in gender-specific cabins with peers in the same age grouping. Youth campers spend their days traveling from camp activity to camp activity as a cabin group. Small groups (2:6 camper to staff ratio) and natural settings provide opportunities for campers to grow individually and as a cabin. Kid and Tween campers participate in similar activity offerings and evening programs while Teen campers participate in separate, and more advanced, programming. Special offerings during youth sessions include: guest programs, equine-assisted therapy, overnight campouts, outdoor skills (specifically for Teens), and an all-out, over the top THEME for all!
