

All of our campers, aged 0-99, are individuals with low vision or blindness. We offer them a safe, well supervised, and supportive environment. We also foster a close-knit community where everyone is accepted and where friendships flourish. This is evident in the fact that most of our campers return summer after summer, calling Highbrook Lodge their home away from home!

Highbrook Lodge is a place where independence and self-sufficiency are encouraged. Campers can improve orientation and mobility skills, increase their ability to live independently and most important, learn while having fun surrounded by natural beauty.

YOUTH PROGRAMS (AGES 7-21)

Outdoor Adventure

Campers with low vision or blindness are encouraged to invite a sighted sibling or friend (aged 12-18) to register and attend, too.

Youth Weeks

Our traditional 5 day, 5 night residential camp is a blast for both new and returning campers, aged 7-21. And this year, we have three weeks to choose from! Grouped with their cabin and age group, campers will participate in a range of age appropriate activities while having fun in the sun with friends Monday through Friday. Activities also include field trips, camp outs, equine therapy, and more.
