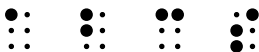

Skill reinforcement program  
(private funding) or ESY (IEP  
goals determined by IEP team) –  
school district funded

**Occupational Therapy (direct)**  
**Physical Therapy (direct)**  
**Speech Therapy (direct)**  
**Vision (direct)**  
**Orientation & Mobility (direct)**

**Benefits:** To child: summer programming to address areas of need and to reduce/prevent summer regression

To parents: half day summer activities (planned & implemented by professional staff to promote independence, mobility & literacy)

To school districts: provision of ESY services, including:  
\*direct therapies (OT, PT, TVI, Speech, O&M)  
\*play based informal assessment & recommendations for school year (if requested)

**Fee:** \$450 per child per 3 week session\*\*  
\$20 per week - transportation fee –  
Cleveland residents (if needed)
