With Bioptics, Aaliyah Sees Her Future

At 16-years-old, Aaliyah was **suddenly navigating a new reality** – vision loss due to complications from lupus. Afraid and unsure how this would impact her future, she connected with Cleveland Sight Center (CSC) for guidance.

"I was very hesitant coming here at first," Aaliyah reflects.

"Then I started coming more and more and I realized this really is like my own little family."

At CSC, Aaliyah was introduced to a range of assistive technologies to maximize her remaining vision,

including bioptics - specialized glasses customized to enhance functional vision. Thanks to financial assistance funded in part by **The Nicole Kahn Endowment Fund for Assistive Technology**, Aaliyah received her bioptics - **valued at around \$2,000** - at no cost to her and her family.

"The bioptics give me vision I didn't think I had anymore."

After becoming the first visually impaired student to complete the phlebotomy and medical assisting program at her high school, Aaliyah is now a full-time college student studying nursing. She is learning how to use her bioptics and other assistive technologies to meet the demands of a rigorous program.

"I am very grateful because these tools challenge me to keep going and doing what people say I can't," Aaliyah shares. "Without donor support, I feel like I would've given up on myself. These tools are the answers to me being successful."
