Target: 3 to 5 year old children with vision impairment entering or returning to preschool

Services: Camp (includes pre-academic activities, outdoor play, therapies, socialization

activities, fun)

Summer Activities Program (privately funded) or ESY (IEP goals determined by

IEP team – school district funded)

Occupational Therapy (direct) Physical Therapy (direct) Speech Therapy (direct)

Orientation & Mobility (direct)

Benefits: To child: summer programming to address areas of need and to reduce/prevent

summer regression

To parents: half day summer activities (planned & implemented by professional

staff to keep child engaged and involved)

<u>To school districts</u>: provision of ESY services, including:

*direct therapies (OT, PT, TVI, Speech, O&M)

*play based assessment & recommendations for next school year

*functional vision evaluation & recommendations (if requested)

Fee: \$500 per child per 5 week session

\$20 per week - transportation fee - Cleveland residents (if needed)
