

Position Title: Golf Assistant

Number of Positions Available: 7

Purpose: To assist a golfer who experiences limited vision or blindness at the driving range and on the golf course.

Location: Washington Golf Course and North Olmstead Golf Club

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist golfers as needed with course navigation, alignment, and angle of approach.
- Provide sighted guide and other visual assistance as needed.
- Build rapport with golf participants, provide encouragement, and promote safety of participants.
- Related duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Volunteer should enjoy golf, however, need not be an experienced golfer. Training may be provided so that volunteers may better assist golfers.
- Strong social and communication skills.
- Physical Abilities
 - Walk on uneven terrain.
 - Bend or stoop multiple times per shift.
 - Stand for 2 hours or more.
 - Lift and carry full golf bag
 - Drive golf cart
- Access to reliable transportation
- Ability to work with a diverse population
- Passion for helping others.
- Successful completion of a background investigation.
- Completion of Cleveland Sight Center Volunteer Orientation.

- Tuesday Evenings May through August
- \$10 fee at each course excluding equipment rental

Age Requirement: 18 +

Dress Code: Khaki's or slacks and collared polo shirt.
