

BrailleNote Apex Workshop – Independence, OH - May18th, 2015

Workshop Description

Completing Academic Assignments with the BrailleNote APEX in a 21st Century Classroom

Braille reading students utilize the BrailleNote APEX on a daily basis to complete numerous academic activities. Dan Brown of HumanWare will facilitate a day long **hands-on workshop** that will focus on accessing and completing classroom assignments with the APEX. Workshop topics will cover the use of **Nemeth**, access to the **UEB code**, pairing with **iOS** devices, access to **email** and **web pages**.

The workshop will begin with activities that focus on math. The Nemeth Tutorial, Nemeth entry into KeyWord documents and back translating math expressions for sighted teachers and peers will be reviewed. Morning activities will wrap up with a review of the UEB code and activating the UEB braille table within the APEX.

In the afternoon participants will review access to main stream documents such as DOCX, PPTX and PDF. Other intermediate topics such accessing web pages and sending and receiving email will be covered. The afternoon session will conclude by exploring the AEPX as a refreshable braille display with iOS devices such as the iPad. Electronic resource materials, including written tutorials and instructional videos, will be cited throughout the day. Time will also be devoted to fielding participant questions.
