Bright Futures Preschool offers an integrated preschool program, licensed by the Ohio Department of Education, for children with visual impairments and their sighted peers. We are looking for typically developing peers ages three to five. Our class is taught by a dually-licensed teacher who is both an Intervention Specialist and a certified PreK-3 Teacher. In addition to the teacher and two teacher assistants, our program also incorporates Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Vision & Braille Instruction and Orientation & Mobility training which leads to a low student-teacher ratio. Our team follows the Creative Curriculum, uses the Handwriting Without Tears program, and follows the Ohio Early Learning & Development Standards.
