The Bright Futures Preschool students are back in the building for the new school year! The staff in the preschool are beyond excited for another great academic year. As a reminder, Bright Futures Preschool serves children who are blind or low vision, as well as sighted peers.

This integrated approach allows for modeling of age-appropriate language and social behavior. The staff differentiates instruction based on each student's strengths and limitations.

Learning in the form of exploration and discovery is incorporated into the following daily activities:

- Circle Time
- Small Group Work/Learning Centers
- Self-Help Skills and Independence
- Snack/Lunch
- Free Play/Accessible Playground
- Story Time
- Music and Movement Time
- Community Field Trips
- Individual and group therapies, including music therapy for all children

The classroom is infused with the added benefit of integrated related service activities for the entire class, delivered by highly qualified and experienced early education teachers, intervention specialists, and dedicated assistant teachers:

- Speech/Language Pathologist (SLP)
- Occupational Therapist (OT)
- Physical Therapist (PT)
- Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist (COMS)
- Teacher of Children with Visual Impairment (TVI)
