

Summer Youth Work Experience

Designed for Young Adults

Cleveland Sight Center's (CSC) Summer Youth Work Experience is designed to give young adults 12-16 hours/week of paid work experience for 5 weeks supported by a job coach at either Petco or Burlington warehouse.

In addition to the paid work experience, students will participate in:

- Workplace readiness activities
- Job/career exploration
- · Post-secondary counseling
- · Advocacy skills
- · Assistive technology training
- Adaptive daily living skills
- Orientation and mobility training (as needed)

The program is 8:30 am-4:00 pm Monday-Friday. Fridays will consist of experiences hosted by CSC, such as:

- A walking field trip to a local museum
- Planning a car wash and bake sale
- Participating in all components of meal planning and preparation
- · Additional recreational outings

Participants will need to provide their own transportation to and from CSC. Once at CSC, transportation will be provided to job sites and outings.
