

Position Title: Taste with the Toddlers: Preschool Lunch Volunteer

Number of Positions Available: 1

Purpose: Help the classroom run smoothly, providing supervision at lunch time in Cleveland Sight Center's Bright Futures preschool.

Location: The Cleveland Sight Center, 1909 E. 101st Street, Cleveland

Key Responsibilities:

- Set up student lunches and assist with the transition to seat students around lunchtime table.
- Provide support to help lunch run smoothly for students, opening snack items, encouraging appropriate student-student interactions, and engaging students in age appropriate conversations. Supervise students to promote their learning and development, encouraging skills such as fine motor skills, imaginative play, turn taking, sharing, and other appropriate skills and behaviors.
- As needed, assist preschool staff with transitions from lunch to the following activity.
- Take responsibility for cleaning up lunch area and running dishwasher.
- Model appropriate behaviors for students.
- Other relevant duties as assigned.

- Possess a High school Diploma or GED
- Passion for working with preschool age children of varying abilities.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- An understanding of and appreciation for diverse populations.
- Ability to autonomously perform listed responsibilities.
- Must be able to stand, stoop, bend, stretch, and walk over a one hour period.
- Experience as a camp counselor, teacher or childcare provider or training in the field of education, occupational therapy, orientation and mobility or related field preferred.
- Ability to schedule and complete a background investigation and provide proof of wellness from a medical care provider.
