- Provide verbal description of non-verbal aspects of local plays, movies, and speeches.
- Pick up and return audio description equipment at Cleveland Sight Center.

- Good speaking skills and ability to describe visual scenes.
- Willingness to be trained by CSC on audio description equipment.
- Access to reliable transportation.
- Ability to work with a diverse population.
- Physical Abilities:
  - Lift or carry 20 lbs multiple times per shift
  - Sit for 2 hour periods
  - Speak clearly and concisely
