Cleveland Sight Center also offers an on-site clinic as well as a retail store with hundreds of products to live well with vision loss.

Cleveland Sight Center (CSC) is also a service provider for a program funded through Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD). Targeted for people age 55 and older, the Independent Living Older Blind (ILOB) Program is a vision rehabilitation training program – an in-home training program – designed for seniors with visual disabilities. The goal is to serve individuals dealing with low vision or blindness, empowering them to maximize their independent functioning who are living in their own home, retirement or assisted living community. The program has no cost to the individuals who participate. Participants will be provided with recommendations for equipment that will help them in their daily functioning; some of that equipment may be purchased for participants.
