Braille Camp

<u>Grades 3-7</u>

This camp is for students with a visual impairment who currently use Braille as a means for written communication and accessing information, and need to improve their Braille Skills. (Student should be involved in statewide testing.) Students will work to improve and enhance existing Braille skills through fun and educational science activities based on Ohio's Learning Standards.

Activities will include instruction in Braille usage, science, letter writing, storytelling, and journal writing skills. Students will also be given assessments to identify and establish Braille proficiency skills. The Summer Braille Immersion Camp will be aligned with Ohio's Learning Standards in the areas of English Language Arts, which include reading, the writing process, and science.
