Purpose: Engage Cleveland Sight Center Bright Futures preschool students, reading them stories during quiet time and interacting with them during recess play.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support the schedule of the classroom by working with students and teachers to select books and read stories aloud during quiet time.
- Supervise preschool students and interact with children to promote their learning and development at recess. Encourage use of fine motor skills, imaginative play, turn taking, sharing, and other appropriate skills and behaviors.
- As needed, assist preschool staff with the set up and clean up of the classroom or planned activities.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Passion for working with preschool age children of varying abilities.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- An understanding of and appreciation for diverse populations.
- Ability to autonomously lead story time activities and monitor recess play.
